FIRE CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made the 17th day of November, 2021, by and between the VILLAGE OF SHORTSVILLE, County of Ontario and State of New York, acting through its Board of Trustees, hereinafter referred to as the "Village", and the TOWN OF HOPEWELL, County of Ontario and State of New York, acting through its Town Board, and hereinafter referred to as the "Town",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been established within the Town of Hopewell a fire protection district, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hopewell is desirous of providing fire protection for that part of said fire protection district described as follows:

All the premises within the Town of Hopewell lying on both sides of the following public Highways: Canandaigua Hopewell Townline Road, County Road 19, Johnson Road, Latting Road, Mapleview Drive, Pinetree Drive, Pioneer Road, Schutt Road, State Route 21, Standpipe Road, and the Freshour Road from the north town line to Taylor Road; and furthermore

The following intersections will be protected as follows: the 4 way intersection of Schutt Road, NYS Route 21, and NYS Route 488 will be protected by the Shortsville Fire Department; the intersection of Taylor Road and Freshour Road will be protected by the Town of Hopewell Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Shortsville passed a resolution authorizing it to contract with the Town of Hopewell for fire protection district described above, and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter mentioned, this agreement shall become effective January 1st, 2022, and shall continue for one year ending December 31st, 2023.

For such consideration, the Village does hereby agree to provide one fire truck equipped with 500-gallon pumper, together with all other equipment and apparatus used in connection with such pumper. The Town of Hopewell shall pay the Village of Shortsville, on or before the 15th of June for each active year of this contract, the following sums for each year listed:

Year 2022- 18,053.00

Year 2023- 19,135.59

The Village further agrees that said fire truck shall be available for and will answer all calls from any part of said fire protection district covered by this agreement.

The Village agrees that said fire truck so responding to a fire call, together with its equipment and apparatus, shall be in good workable condition and repairs and shall be manned by a suitable number of well-trained firemen.

It is further understood and agreed between the parties herein that the Village shall in no way be held responsible for delay or failure in reaching the scene of a fire because of impassable

roads or conditions over which it has no control or for failure to extinguish a fire after reasonable effort.

It is further understood and agreed that the agreement shall continue for a period of one year commencing January 1st, 2022. Either party may notify the other party in writing prior to or before August 20th next preceding the intended termination date, if it elects to terminate this Agreement on December 31st of that year, but in any event this agreement shall terminate on December 31st, 2023.

The notice herein provided for shall be served on the same manner as is required for the service of a summons in an action in Supreme Court.

FIRE CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made the 17th day of November, 2021, by and between the TOWN OF HOPEWELL, County of Ontario and State of New York, hereinafter called the "Town", and the HOPEWELL FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC. a New York corporation, with its principal office in the Town of Hopewell, County of Ontario and State of New York, hereinafter called the "Fire Department".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Town of Hopewell is desirous to provide fire protection for part of the Hopewell Fire Protection district of the Town of Hopewell,

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Hopewell Fire Department, Inc. shall furnish fire protection services for all the premises within the Town of Hopewell lying on both sides of the following public Highways for that area included in the below described area.

A geographical area beginning at the southeast corner of the Town, thence westerly along town line to the southwest corner of the Town, thence northerly along the Town of Canandaigua – Town of Hopewell line to a point located in the center of the Canandaigua Lake Outlet, thence following the centerline of said waterbody to the intersection of State Route 488, thence westerly along State Route 488 to the intersection of State Route #21, thence easterly along State Route 488 to Freshour Road, thence northerly along Freshour Road to the intersection of Taylor Road, thence easterly along Taylor Road to the Pettit Road, thence southerly along Pettit Road to Route 488, thence easterly along Route 488 to Malone Road, thence southerly along Malone Road to County Road 4, thence along County Road 4 to the easterly town line, thence southerly along town line to the place of beginning, together with properties within the Town of Hopewell adjoining the highway constituting boundaries of said fire protection area.

The following intersections will be protected by the Hopewell Fire Department:

- Intersection at Taylor Road and Freshour Road
- Intersection at Boyce Road, Taylor Road and Pettit Road
- Intersection at State Route 488 and Archer Road

2. The Town of Hopewell shall pay the said Fire Department using the following schedule:

Year 2022-	319,370.00
Year 2023-	328,951.10

3. The term of the contract will be from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023.
4. Notice of termination by either party shall be on or before August 20th of any year.
